Do not bring your own range balls. A clip board for scoring.  
Appropriate weather gear. Be prepared to walk the course.
- NOTE: Mountain View Golf Course WILL NOT BILL THE SCHOOL.
- Date/Time: Wednesday, May 5<sup>th</sup> by 7:20 am  
Coaches Meeting at 7:30 am  
Send players out at 7:50 am (approx.)  
Shot gun start at 8:00 am
- Dress: Collared Golf Shirt  
Appropriate pants  
No jeans, no "cargo" pants, golf shorts are ok  
Shirt tucked in, don't wear hat backwards
- Do Not: **Do Not** bring any extra players (bring 5 only)  
Parents, friends, etc. are **NOT PERMITTED** on course.  
Tell your players that swearing, club throwing, smoking,  
etc., will result in disqualification!
- Rules: It is the player's responsibility to know the rules of golf.  
Violators are subject to penalties or disqualification. You  
must play by U.S.G.A rules.
- Food: Available at grill room (bring cash). You must continue your  
groups pace if you have lunch.
- Cell Phones: COACHES MUST TELL THEIR PLAYERS TO **NOT BRING CELL PHONES.**
- Summer Rules: Unless told differently at the course on Tournament Day.
- When in Doubt: Play 2 different balls, record both scores and discuss with  
officials after play.

### **General Information:**

The Mercer County Golf Tournament will be held on Wednesday, May 5<sup>th</sup> at the Mountain View Golf Course. A maximum of five players may participate from each team. The four low medal scores will count toward the team score.

A plaque will be awarded to the winning team with medals being awarded to the lowest seven individual medal scores of the day. Team ties will be broken by teams participating in a sudden death tournament format. Ties for individual awards will be broken by a match of cards beginning on hole #18 backwards with the exception of first or second place, which will be determined by a sudden death playoff beginning with hole #18.

Teams are expected to arrive by 7:20 am. There will be a meeting of coaches at 7:30 am in the Mercer Oaks dining room.

First tee-off time will be at 8:00 am (Shot gun Start)

### **Rules:**

USGA rules govern play except for stated local rules.

Lost Ball Rule: USGA Stroke and Distance

Any unsportsmanlike conduct may result in disqualification. All players must be dressed in proper attire according to regulations. Shorts, not cutoffs, are permissible. No cell phones and no tobacco products.

In past tournaments parents have positioned themselves at locations on the course as spectators not interfering with the golfers. This situation is tolerated, although not encouraged, as we do not have a large group wandering the course. What we cannot allow is a non-competing individual to walk the course with participants. They will be asked to leave by the tournament committee. This situation could result in a penalty.

Riding golf carts will be available for coaches at a cost of \$8.00; however we encourage you to walk.

Range balls will be available for \$4.00 a bucket. Money must be paid at the pro shop.

A buffet will be available after the tournament courtesy of the Colonial Valley Conference, Principals and Athletic Directors.
