Entry Forms:

Entry Date:

All games played through Saturday, October 15, 2011 will count for selection.

- Teams will be seeded on Tuesday, October 18, 2011. Game information will be sent via fax, e-mail or phone on Tuesday, October 18, 2011.

Games:

- All teams entering the tournament agree to make themselves available to the following game schedules.
 - Thursday, October 20 – Play-In Games if needed
 - Saturday, October 22– 1st Round Games at higher seeded team (Games with Preps may need to be played on October 21 due to their state tournament)
 - Monday, October 24– 2nd Round Games Start time 3:30 pm
Consolation Games @ higher seeded team
 - Wednesday, October 26 - Semi – Final Championship Bracket @MCCC and/or @ Ewing
at 5:30 pm or 7:30 pm
Consolation Games @ higher seeded team
 - Saturday, October 29 – Championship @ Rider University-7:30pm Boys Final
 - **Each school is required to play two games & a third if desirable.**
 - **The Semi's & Finals will have three officials.**
- All Games will be played at the higher seeded team except for the semi-finals and finals of the championship bracket. Consolation games will be played at the higher seed with a 3:30 pm start (**Consolation games can be played any day during MCT week due to lack of officials.**)
- Teams should follow enclosed bracket sheet closely.
- Specific instructions for championship game will be given at later date.
- Adjustments to this schedule may be made due to weather, state tournaments, and/or field availability.

Officials:

- Officials will be assigned by the soccer assignor, Michael Luciano. The home team will be responsible for paying both officials. **In the semi's, each school will split the cost of the three official. The FINALS will be paid by the MCT.**

Games:

- **All ties, including the Finals, will be broken as determined by the NJSIAA state tournament rule. Two 10 minute over times, with the "golden goal" rule in effect, then a shoot-out if needed.**
- In the Semi-final, the higher seeded teams are required to bring four (4) soccer balls with the NFHS stamp of approval.
- In the Finals, the MCT will supply four (4) soccer balls with the NFHS stamp of approval.
- **Each School should bring one (1) faculty member to be responsible for their fans.**
- **Remind student body/ spectators that noise makers and banners (signs) are prohibited at ALL game sites.**
- **Higher seeded team is responsible to supply an athletic trainer for the game.**
- Admission: ADULTS \$3.00 SENIORS AND STUDENTS \$2.00 at all semis and finals
